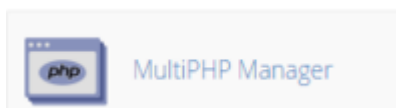
MultiPHP Manager

We allow you to select the PHP you would like for each of your assets hosted on us. eSGR is using PHP 7.0 by default (Check current [Software Versions](#)).

If you need an older or newer version of PHP you can use the MultiPHP Manager in your cPanel Account.

Changing PHP Version

- Click on the MultiPHP Manager



- From the list of assets you can see the version used

System PHP Version

The system default PHP version is set by the system administrator. Any domain that is set to the inherit value indicates that it does not have its own PHP version explicitly set. Read more about [inherit](#).

Select the domains that you wish to change from the table, then apply a PHP version from the list.

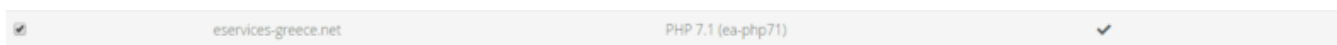
